<u>Literacy Tips for Families</u>

- ❖ Be a reading role model. When your child sees adults in their life read, it reinforces the importance of reading in your family life.
- ❖ Have fun with reading. Make it a family event. Talk about what you are reading or play an audio book while driving on vacation or around town.
- Talk to your child about what they are reading. Ask open-ended questions such as why is the main character important to the story?
- ❖ Go to the library together. Ask the librarian for help in finding books for your children will enjoy.
- Ask older children to read to younger ones.

What Do We Want Students to Do for Summer Reading?

- We want students to be readers.
- We encourage all students to find books or other literature that interests them such as magazines, blogs, newspapers, eBooks, or audio books.
- The important thing to remember is just to continue to read throughout the summer and have fun with what you read.

6 books Rising 1st grade

Rising 2nd & 3rd grade 4-6 books

Rising 4th & 5th grade 4-5 books

Rising 6th grade 4 books
